What Do I Need To Bring??

- Healthy Lunch and a drink
- Raincoat /Jacket
- Change of clothes
- Suitable shoes

Parents/Caregiver Information

We welcome your child to the Neighbourhood Trust/ Glenmoor Holiday Programme.

Supervision and Safety

- Our staff are all experienced in child care and at least one staff member trained in first aid will be present at all times.
- Staff ratio is minimum of 1:8 on outings.

Behaviour Management

- Parents/Caregivers need to be aware that because safety is our first consideration our policy needs to be strictly adhered to.
- Parents will be notified if their child/children are causing a disruption on the programme. Where serious harm may happen or occur, the programme management reserves the right to remove the child from the programme or to decline acceptance of the child onto the programme. If a child is found to have any illness/behaviour condition which has not been included on the registration form, we reserve the right to remove the child from the programme.

Complaints Procedure

Please raise your concerns, suggestions or complaints with the programme supervisor and they will get you to fill in the appropriate form.

Health & Medical Conditions

If a child has a condition that requires medication, this will need to be detailed on the enrolment form and a separate Medical Consent form filled in. Medication will only be administered when consent is given.

Sickness

Out of consideration for the other participants, please do not bring unwell children to the programme. However, please notify the Supervisor on the day of the child's sickness before **8.30am**. Phone: (027) 487 0587.
